ENTRIES:	1st & 2nd Place Team trophies will be awarded at the conclusion of the meet. The purpose of the meet is to involve as many athletes as possible, therefore, you are not limited to varsity athletes. However, each athlete is limited to four events. Please make sure that you enter your athletes in the meet according to their team rank in each event. You <u>must</u> fill Class A first, then B, and finally C. You cannot run a lower class without filling the higher classes. If you're A athlete is not used, then B and C must move up respectively. Please follow the "spirit of the meet" when doing your entries and make every effort to enter every competition. Substitutions may be made the day of the meet. If a substitution changes the order of your athletes in that event, then you must adjust your entries accordingly.		

ENTRIES: We will be going with a FAT system this year. Entries will be made on athletic.net. Entries are due by midnight on Monday, April 30th. Instructions are included.

- STARTINGWe will establish starting heights for each class in the pole vault and the high jump.HEIGHTS:The starting height will be based on the eighth best entry for each class. Once the
starting height is determined, no athlete may attempt a height below the minimum
standard for that class. In addition, the time limit rule will be adhered to during the
competition.
- **ODDS & ENDS:** To help us run the meet in an efficient manner please remind your athletes of the following:
 - 1) Track spikes should be no longer than ¼".
 - 2) Athletes should stay away from the finish line.
 - 3) Athletes should report promptly to the staging area upon third call.
 - 4) Team camps should be established in the east bleachers.

There will be a concession stand hosted by track team parents. Hot dogs, pop, Gatorade, candy, popcorn, coffee, and pizza will be available.
