**Entries**:

One relay team at each level and two individuals at each level (Varsity & F/S). Athletes cannot compete in both Varsity & F/S levels. All entries must be made online by **10:00pm, Thursday, April 6<sup>th</sup>.** We will be using athletic.net for meet entries. Because this is often the first outdoor meet on many team schedules, turning in legitimate seed times for certain races (100/300 hurdles, 4x100, etc.) is not possible. Our goal is to have competitive heats and fair heat/lane positions as much as possible, so please use your best coaching judgment to estimate times for those events not run during the indoor season.

We will also run an **Open 1600m Run and an Open 100m Dash**. We did not place a limit on the number of athletes in these events, but please try to keep your entries to a manageable amount. You must make online entries for these events as well.

**Scoring**: All relays and individuals will be scored to 6 places (10-8-6-4-2-1).

**Awards**:  $1^{st}$  Place Team Trophies for each level. Medals for  $1^{st} - 5^{th}$  place for the Varsity and Ribbons for

1<sup>st</sup> – 5<sup>th</sup> place for the Frosh/Soph.

**Camps**: Make team camps in the bleachers or the area surrounding the bleachers.

**Food:** There will be a hospitality lunch available for coaches and adult workers in the south squad

room. Concessions will be available for athletes.

Workers: We are asking each school to provide a competent field event worker. DGS will have student

helpers at each field event as well. We also would like each school to provide a coach to supervise exchange zones during the sprint relays.
