This week, fans will have a chance to see the Hilltoppers in action in the Glenbard West Sectional being held in Biester Gym.

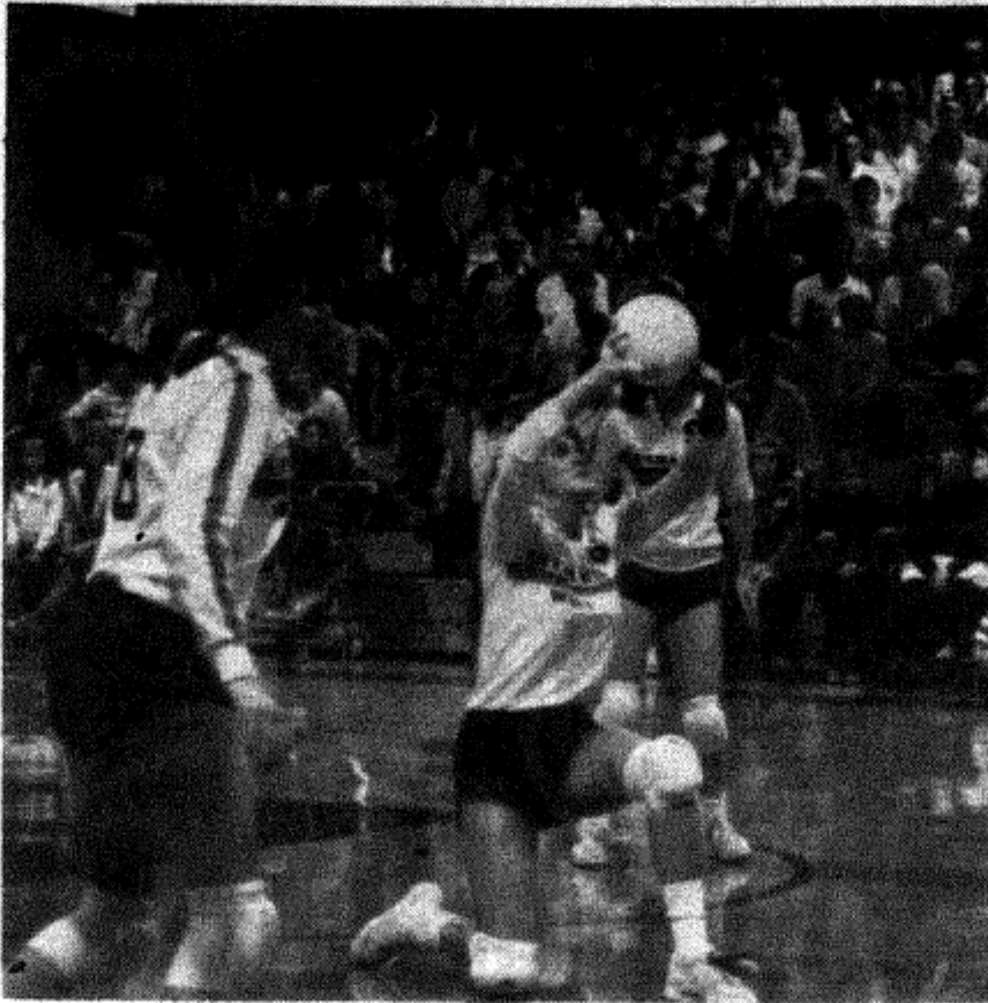

Lena Chiou was the first server for West in the second game. She put the Hilltoppers out on top with a 6-0 lead before the Raiders could re-group. The Spikers went on to win the game, 15-5, along with the match.

In the first round of the Regional, the Hilltoppers destroyed the Wheaton Central Tigers, 15-0, 15-5. The Spikers only took 25 minutes to win.

Chiou also did an outstanding job at serving in the victory over the Tigers. She served in the first 12 points of the first game to lead West to the shutout.
