

The Hinsdale Central varsity girls cross country team finished third at the St. Charles North Invitational Saturday, Oct. 3, at LeRoy Oakes Forest Preserve. Sophomores Reilly Revord (18:12.0) and Grace McCabe (18:30.8) were sixth and ninth on this year's new 3.0-mile course. Revord was 7.8 seconds from a top-five finish.

Senior Mackie Stevens was 21st (19:09.0) to also earn a top-25 individual medal, followed by junior Molly Caveney (37th, 19:35.8), senior Emma Sullivan (56th, 20:01.8), freshman Taylor Waldron in her varsity debut (60th, 20:10.5) and sophomore Sophia Horowicz (100th, 21:14.6).

The Red Devils (129 points), ranked No. 14 this week in Class 3A by DyeStatIL, finished behind No. 3 Batavia (69) and No. 5 Lyons Township (99) with No. 13 Geneva (137) fourth.

Geneva senior McKenzie Altmayer (17:44.8), 11th at state last, won the race by 7.8 seconds.
