Starting Blocks Wheaton Warrenville South High School will provide starting blocks.

Relay/Runway Markers Albsolutely no tape may be used for relay or runway marks. Chalk will be provided.

Facilities

Our track is an all weather nine-lane 400-meter track. No spikes longer than 4 may be used. Shot Put and Discus platforms are concrete. Concessions and rest rooms are available at the Northeast corner of

the track. Please see the facility map for details.

High Jump

In an effort to offer the best competitive environment possible, we will continue this to split the high jump into two flights. We are not going to have a set cut off height, but we will probably use 5-00. The final determination will be made by the Meet Director. Starting heights will be determined when entries are final. Both flights are eligible to score and ties will be broken using standard procedures.

Pole Vault

In an effort to offer the best competitive environment possible, we will continue this to split the pole vault into two flights. We are not going to have a set cut off height, but we will probably use 9-00 for pole vault as our guides. The final determination will be made by the Meet Director. Starting heights will be determined when entries are final. Both flights are eligible to score and ties will be broken using standard procedures.

Shot Put/ Discus Four throws, best of four attempts. Four (4) total flights. The first flights for <u>BOTH</u> shot put and Discus will begin at 4:30. Impliments will be and weighed checked from 3:30 to 4:00 in the track garage located at the Northeast corner of the track.

Long Jump/ Triple Jump Best of four attempts. Four (4) total flights. Flights will be called in order.
