USAG events during the HS Season:

Tracie Henry reviewed with the committee the process for IHSA By-law 3.101 which prohibits a student from participating on a non-school team or in non-school competition in the sport or any skill of a sport at the time the student is a member of a school team in that same sport. During the school term, special permission may be granted to permit a student to compete in a non-school event during the school season in competitions which are directly sanctioned by the national governing body for the sport or its official Illinois affiliate. No student may participate in more than three (3) approved non-school competitions during a sports season. Non-school participation requests can only be accessed by school administrators through the IHSA Schools Center website

News from the IHSA Advisory Committee:

Proposals that were approved:

(GIRLS) XI. OFFICIALS 3) State Final:

Recommendation: a. 9 judges shall be assigned to the preliminary session at the State Final.

Rational: Moving to a 2-judge panel per event is consistent with how gymnasts are judged throughout the season. The current state final prelim scoring system drops the high and low score and averages the two in the middle, the change in prelim assignments would average the scores received from the two assigned judges. This recommendation also will allow for more space on the competition floor.

(GIRLS) Scoresheet

Recommendation: Edit the Illinois specific scoresheet to include more detail and professional formatting.

Rational: The information added to the scoresheet will provide coaches with clearer understanding to educate themselves and their gymnasts on the judges scoring.
